Tollway operators warned of penalties, suspension over RFID mess

MANILA - The Toll Regulatory Board (TRB) warned tollway operators of penalties possible and over suspension violations of the implementing rules and regulations of cashless transactions expressways.

In a statement on Tuesday evening, the TRB said its continuing operations and systems audit in enforcing cashless transactions in plazas has identified glitches that have been relayed to toll operators.

"These glitches, admitted by the North Luzon Expressway (NLEx) Corp. to be happening, are not new to TRB management and were subject to notices to correct," the TRB said.

To avoid penalties possible suspension, it ordered toll operators to "aggressively pursue consistently implement" measures that would fix issues with their radio frequency identification (RFID) systems and help ease traffic.

These include the immediate replacement worn-out defective RFID sensors, related **RFID** equipment, and RFID

tags; relocation of RFID installation and reloading lanes that hamper traffic flow; maintenance or

upgrade of systems software; enhancing traffic management, and improving customer service.

Lack of sleep makes body more vulnerable to infections

ISTANBUL – Sleep, exercise, and stress control are significant factors for a strong immune system, said Turkish scientists Monday, warning that sleep deprivation causes vulnerability to infectious diseases.

"Get enough sleep so that enough melatonin is secreted, do not smoke, do not use tobacco products, eat a diet rich in vegetables and fruits, exercise regularly," Turkish Kidney Foundation said in a statement on ways to strengthen the immune system.

The foundation also recommended washing hands regularly and properly, as well as reducing stress levels.

"It has been shown that the immune system is impaired and vulnerability to infections rises in many sleep-related diseases," said Dr. Derya Karadeniz, an expert on sleep disorders,

stressing the role of sleep in body repair.

Experimental studies prove a strong relationship between the immune system and sleep, she noted, adding that in a study in which people who were only allowed four hours of sleep for four nights had much weaker immune responses when given the flu vaccine on the fifth day compared to those who had regular hours of sleep.

Timur Erk, the head of the foundation, warned that essential vitamins and minerals should be taken to meet the needs of people amid the coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) pandemic.

"Healthy diet, exercise, stress control, and sleep ... A saying of our grandmothers, 'children grow asleep', now applies to all individuals and has been proven by scientific research," he added. (Anadolu)

Valenzuela City Mayor cashless

Monday, the TRB said the matter is "between the City of Valenzuela company and the NLEx fees in its operator."

"We have been assured that this is being given appropriate attention and hoped to be resolved very soon," the board said.

Earlier, the NLEx Corp. said it would seek "a series of dialogues" with Gatchalian after the revocation of their business permit in Valenzuela City over heavy traffic caused by the implementation of cashless toll transactions.

The revocation of the permit forced the company to waive toll fees in its toll gates in the city, specifically the Karuhatan-Mindanao Avenue Toll Plaza, Karuhatan-Harborlink Toll Plaza, Karuhatan-MacArthur Highway Sub-Exit, Mindanao Avenue Toll Plaza, Paso de Blas Toll Plaza North Bound, Paso de Blas Toll Plaza South Bound, and Lawang Bato Toll Booth. Led by Maliksi, the grant was in partnership with Manila Electric Company (Meralco) under the Imus City Legacy Projects which aims to create a clean and green city.

environmental-friendly alternatives to sustain its increasing energy demand due to the Covid-19 pandemic, which forced the citizens of Imus to use more electricity to cope with the new normal of education.

"The school program aims [to] create a healthy environment that is conducive to learning while saving energy, resources, and money. This is the process where [schools] pursue knowledge practices with intentions of becoming more environmentally friendly and more e c o n o m i c a l l y responsible," Rosaroso said.

With continuous support of the City Government of Imus and Schools Division Office (SDO) of Imus City, DepEd, and the Department of Environment Natural Resources (DENR), Rosaroso expressed hope that the project will encourage the youth to contribute to creating more sustainable approaches in the environment.

[I] want our learners to realize that despite the pandemic, schools [should] not stop pursuing education sustainability and that they should not stop learning," Rosaroso said. (PR)

can still get better for the benefit of our customers," Panlilio said.

To elevate Smart to global standards, he said the company is aiming for minimum average broadband speeds of at least 30 megabits per second (Mbps) in Metro Manila and some other key cities by 2021 through its LTE network.

By 2025, he said they are aiming for 84 percent of the population to have an average mobile data speed of 60 Mbps.

PLDT with its wired broadband service, he said, targets an average of 20 Mbps aside from its planned migration of legacy DSL copper line subscribers to fiber and "fiber-like services."

PLDT has rolled out close to 100,000 kilometers of fiber lines for this year alone, noting that all four broadband players in the country rolled out a total of 144,727 kilometers for this year, according to the N a t i o n a l Telecommunications Commission (NTC).

In total, PLDT said its fiber infrastructure now spans more than 422,000 kms and supports Smart's 4G, 3G, and 2G networks.

"As of November, has Smart increased the number of its LTE and 3G base stations to over 58,000, increasing the number of LTE base stations by 20 percent compared to end-2019. Smart has rolled also additional 5G sites as it accelerates its 5G commercial services nationwide," PLDT-Smart said.

To date, it said Smart's mobile network covers 96 percent of the population and is present in 95 percent of cities and municipalities in the country. (By Raymond Carl Dela Cruz/PNA)

Tanza receives school building from SM

SM Prime, through SM Foundation, formally turned over a two-story, four-classroom school building to Punta Elementary School (PES) in Tanza, Cavite on November 20.

These classrooms are set to be utilized by Grade 2 pupils once the threat of COVID-19 subsides. According to the school principal, Dr. Gloria Casiano, before the COVID pandemic, some of their classes are held in their covered court. This SM school building will help address their room shortages and will improve their current classroom to student ratio of 1:50.

"We are overwhelmed and thankful to SMFoundation and SM Prime for continuing with the project despite COVID-19 the pandemic. This school building will serve as a haven in nurturing the young minds of our Puntaceño learners," Dr. Casiano said.

Following the default design of SM school buildings, this infrastructure is fullyfurnished, PWDfriendly and emergency-ready. SMMoreover, Foundation tapped the members of the Foundation of These-Abled Persons to make the teacher's desk sets and student armchairs. Through this strategy, SMFI is enabling the PWDsto be economically selfsufficient and at the same time, highlights their valuable contribution in nationbuilding.

To care for the wellness of the school population, additional features were also installed such as a library hub, guidance and counselling room, and a clinic with an isolation room where pupils can be given first aid treatment or isolated at the onset of early symptoms of illness.

The SM School building also boasts a 10-faucet handwashing area that intends to promote handwashing in the community. With such feature, SMFI aims to spread the culture of good hygiene — which prevents the spread of harmful viruses and diseases.

Established in June 1937, the PES is one of the oldest schools in the municipality with a 50year-old tree that stands in the campus. In order to promote the culture environmental of conservation, Foundation developed the area into a study garden or "green space" by putting four tables and eight benches around the tree. With the green space, SM intends to reduce the stress of the children, enhance their mental health, concentration and environmental awareness – aside from providing the students and teachers with additional learning area.

In addition to Punta Elementary School, Basud Elementary School in Sorsogon City and Banisil Elementary School in General Santos are also scheduled to receive a fully-furnished school building this year.

SM Foundation, through its School Building Program, is an active partner of DepEd's Adopt-a-School program. This social good initiative aims to promote quality public education by building classrooms nationwide.
