DSWD commends 562 families for graduating from 4Ps

MANILA – Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Secretary Rex Gatchalian on Wednesday commended 526 households for hurdling the stage of sending their children to school through the government's Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps). "Kahit saan tayo tumingin umaabot tayo sa part ng programa kung saan ang mga anak ninyo, nakakatapos ng pagnakakahanap aaral, ng maayos na trabaho (Wherever we look, we reached the part of the program where your children can fin-

ish their studies, can find decent jobs)," Gatchalian said in his speech during the Pugay Tagumpay ceremonial graduation of 562 beneficiaries of 4Ps in Plaridel, Bulacan

DA: PH has sufficient rice supply for Q3 of 2023

MANILA – The country has a sufficient supply of rice, the Department of Agriculture (DA) assured the public on Tuesday, amid the surge in the prices of the country's staple food.

In a statement, DA Undersecre-Senior tary Leocadio Sebastian said the rice supply is enough to meet the Filipinos' food requirements in the third quarter of 2023.

Sebastian said the

carry-over stock of 1.8 million metric tons (MMT) milled rice and import arrival of 1.8MMT are enough to fill in the demand and consumption of seven MMT from January to June.

"By the end of June, the stock available will be good for more than two months, in (addition) to the incoming supply from the new harvest and import arrivals in the coming months," Sebastian,

who heads the DA's Masagana Rice Industry Program (MRIP), said.

Sebastian attributed the current movement in rice prices to the "high cost of production locally and globally."

"We expect this to stabilize," he said.

He said a "bountiful" harvest for the January to June rice planting season is seen to boost the supply by 6 percent.

PAGASA: El Niño no effect yet this planting season

MANILA – The Philippine weather bureau said the lower rainfall phenomenon of El Niño is not yet in effect, and rice farmers would have enough rainfall for the July to September planting season.

"There will be near to normal rain from July to September 2023," said the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical, and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) said in a statement on Tuesday.

Analyn Solis of PA-GASA said the chances of feeling the effects of El Niño are getting higher, but the lower rainfall pattern in the coming months has not been established vet.

"Mataas ang possibility ng El Niño. Sa July, maglalabas ulit kami ng advisory with a forecast for affected provinces. Hindi pa dumadating rainfall pattern, kung kelan ba ang effect. May reduction ng ulan pero it does not always mean drought. Mataas ang potential ng pag-ulan ngayon (The possibility of El Niño is high. In July, we will again issue an advisory with a forecast for affected provinces. Rainfall pattern is yet to arrive,

when will the effect be. There is a reduction in rain, but it does not always mean drought. Rain potential is high today)," Solis said.

She said rainfall is expected to decrease in September and to drop further from October to December this year.

As this is the harvest season, low rainfall benefits rice farmers, said former Agriculture Secretary and Federation of Free Farmers president Raul Montemayor.

PAGASA's rainfall forecast is only up to December 2023.

"For December, 36 provinces will experience dry spell, drought for two provinces," Solis said.

Farmer Rene Cerilla, in a forum conducted by Tugon Kabuhayan on Monday, said that farmers are under the false impression that El Niño is arriving this July.

"That's why it is so important for us to have the correct information so that we could make the right decisions and plan accordingly. If there is a shortage of water, we have to plant crops that don't require as much water, like corn and monggo," Cerilla

PH positivity rate further dips to 7.8%: OCTA

MANILA — The nation's positivity rate, or the number of individuals who tested positive for the coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19), further dipped to 7.8 percent as of June 27.

In a Twitter post on Wednesday, OCTA Research Group fellow Dr. Guido David said the country's positivity rate has been decreasing from 8.6 percent on June 23.

The figure went down further to 8.2 percent on June 24, to 8.1 percent on June 25, and to 8 percent on June 26.

David said the Department of Health (DOH) logged 297 new Covid-19 infections nationwide on Tuesday, with 63 cases from the National Capital Region (NCR).

These brought the total tally to 4,163,472, with 7,760 active cases, 4,089,229 recoveries, and 66,483 deaths.

Moreover, about 27 new cases of Omicron subvariant XBB.1.16 or "Arcturus" cases and 46 fresh cases of other Omicron subvariant infections were recorded, specifically in Western Visayas, on June 23.

In a televised public briefing on Wednesday, Philippine Federation of Professionals Association Vice President 3 Dr. Benito Atienza said cases must still be monitored despite Health Secretary Teodoro Herbosa's plan to recommend the lifting of the Covid-19 state of public health emergency in the country.

Atienza said the alert level system must be maintained as it would serve as a guide for Filipinos, especially for health care workers and hospitals, regarding the country's Covid-19 situation.

He also reminded everyone to get vaccinated, receive their booster shots, and observe public health protocols, such as wearing of face masks, physical distancing, and frequent hand washing. (PNA)
